In the last few years there has been an ever growing demand for documents to be emailed to those requesting such things. These requests puts an additional burden on office hours to locate, scan and email. The costs for this type of service was reviewed with other town clerk offices and new rates for this type of service was set.

The Secretary of State's Office has rolled out a new online voter registration website. The new website will allow all eligible Vermonters to submit their voter registration application online anytime and anywhere you can access the internet. Also a new "My Voter Page" is an online resource that allows every registered voter to login and have access to a unique, voter-specific web page where you can request an absentee ballot, track your status, update your voter registration record, find your polling place and much more.
