

The new Tetherball game has been installed at the Rec Field. Enjoy and please follow the below listed safety issue and the rules of the game.

Tetherball Rules and Safety

WARNING: DO NOT CLIMB ON POLE OR HANG ON TETHERBALL ROPE. THIS MAY CAUSE THE POLE TO FAIL AND INJURY TO OCCUR.

Playing Rules-the playing area consists of a circle, 20 feet in diameter, divided into two playing areas. One player begins by tossing the ball into the air and hitting the ball in any direction he chooses. The opposing player cannot hit the ball until it passed on its second swing around the pole. Each player's goal is to wind the rope completely around the pole in the direction of his play. The player who wins four out of seven games wins.

Fouls: Ball goes to opponent when;

Striking the ball with any part other than hands or the forearms.

Holding or catching the ball during play.

Touching the pole with any part of the body during play.

Playing outside his designated playing area.
